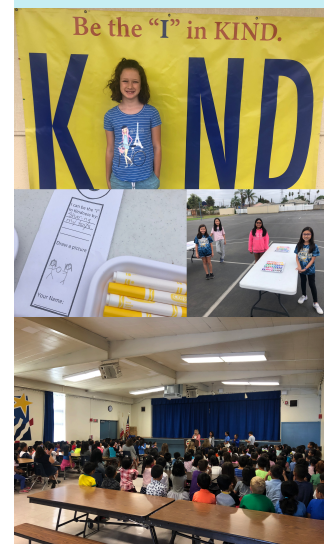

Dear Partners in Learning,

This year, several changes have been made to our bell schedule. PE has been changed from 30 minutes four days a week, to 50 minutes two days a week. We have made sure that our instructional minutes are in alignment with board policies. However, the most notable change has been to our Wednesday lunch time. In order to provide consistency with the structure of the whole week, and in order to meet Federal guidelines, our lunch time is now a scheduled part of the school day. With these changes, we continue to need your support. When you take your child out early, or bring them late to school, they miss important parts of the school day. Learning starts for AM Kindergarten at 8:00, and at 8:15 for grades 1-6. On Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Fridays students in grades 1-3 are released at 2:30. Students in grades 4-6 are dismissed at 2:40, however please note this is the time they are released from their classroom, and need to walk from the back of campus, so please allow a few extra minutes. On Wednesdays, students in grades 1-3 are released at 1:00, and in grades 4-6 they are released at 1:10. All students, including Kindergarten students must sit and have a meal at lunch time. Students may buy or bring their lunch, but this time is not optional, and is a scheduled part of the school day. If you are running late, please call the school office, 548-5085, and let us know, so your students are not worried. Thank you for your continued partnership and support as we continue to provide a program that supports the learning for all students.
